2 Competition location

BALTIC OPEN bouldering edition will take place in Riga from 31st of March to 1st of April, 2012 at Exhibition hall BT1, Ķīpsalas 8, Rīga, LV-1048, during exhibition Sport and Leasure 2012

Height 4m, width 15m, routes overhanging 1-2 metres

On the competition days registration will finish 2 hour before each groups starting time according to provisional programme. (group ED 1 hour) It will be strictly observed.

Advanced registration should include following information:

Name, Surname, Year of birth, sex, country, team, e-mail address.

On registration before competition climbers must hand in copy of passport and 1 passport size photo for entrance passes in competition site

8 Rules

Qualification - all routes open. Whole group stars at one time

Each climber will have unlimited attempts on each route in their category.

Final - closed. Climbers enter arena one by one. Alternatively climbing and resting with the same length of time

9 Protests

Protests are accepted not later then 0.5 hours after official results are posted. Protest consideration fee 25 LVL

10 Accommodation and visas

Please contact organisers ASAP with information how many people you are and what kind of accommodation you wish and we will do our best to help you. This will be done between 15^{th} and 25^{rth} of March

For receiving visas see attachment, but take into account that it takes some time and could not be done later then 2 weeks before competitions. All personal details should be by organizers disposition no later than 16th of March
